## RE : WATERCRAFT ON LAGOON EMBANKMENT

Dear Reader

Due to the number visitors to the Nature's Valley area, residents and visitors are hereby requested to please leave their paddle skis, canoes, row-boats at or near to the rails on either end of the grassed embankment.

It is unsightly to have the entire area strewn with craft and also creates a situation whereby the other visitors in the area have to walk around or over the watercraft in order to also enjoy the scenic beauty and tranquillity of the area.

As the managing authority of the embankment, SANParks-Tsitsikamma National Park will enforce the NEMA legislation under the Protected Areas Act 57 of 2003, and remove the offending crafts/boats should they be deemed in contravention of this act.

Tsitsikamma National Park rangers will be patrolling the area on a more frequent basis and any offenders shall be issued with fines or possible prosecution under the said act.
